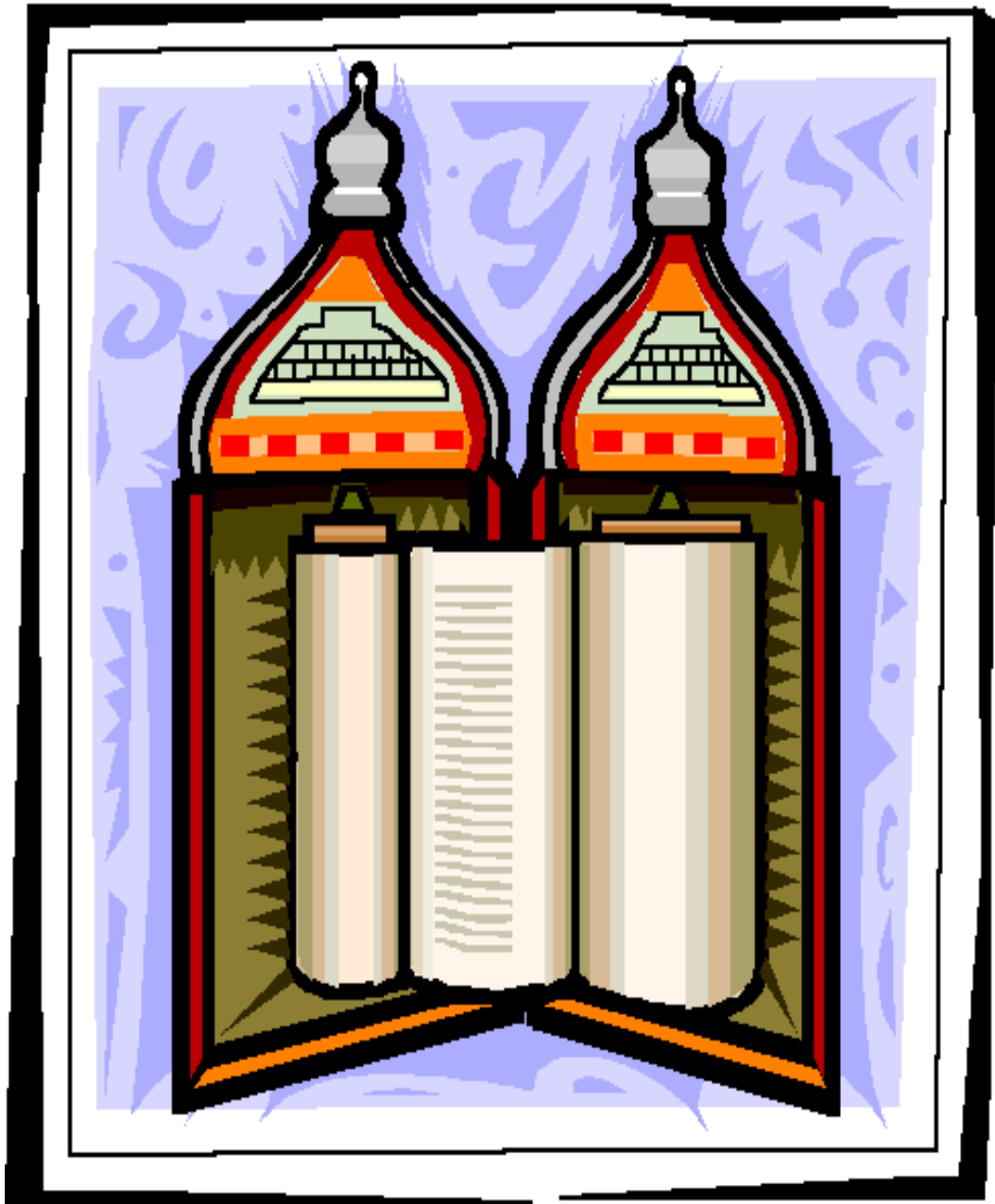

Psalms and Opening Prayer
Call to Worship (*All Rise*)

Cantor: שׁוֹכֵן O L-RD, Who inhabits eternity, Your Name is exalted and holy.ⁱ

Congregation: And as it is written, rejoice in the L-RD, O you righteous. It is befitting for the upright to praise Him.ⁱⁱ By the lips of the 'upright, You shall be praised. By the words of the ^srighteous, You shall be blessed. By the tongue of the ^ffaithful, You shall be extolled. And in the midst of the ^pholy, You shall be sanctified.

Ma Tovu

מָה טוֹבוֹ

Ma tovu ohalecha Ya-akov, mishk'notecha Yisrael
How goodly your tents, O Jacob, your habitations, O Israel!ⁱⁱⁱ

As for me, in the abundance of Your loving-kindness, I will come into Your house. I will worship toward Your holy temple in awe of You.^{iv} O L-RD, I love to be in Your presence, in the place where Your glory dwells.^v As for me, I will worship You in humility; I will bend my knee before You, O L-RD, my Maker.^{vi} I offer my prayer to You, O L-RD, at a time of grace. O God, in the abundance of Your loving-kindness, answer me with the truth of Your Salvation.^{vii}

The Ten Commandments^{viii}

וַיִּדְבֹר And God spoke all these words, saying:

⊞ I am the L-RD thy God, who has brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shall have no other gods before Me.

⊞ Thou shall not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. Thou shall not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them; for I the L-RD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments.

⊖ Thou shall not take the Name of the L-RD thy God in vain; for the L-RD will not hold him guiltless that takes His Name in vain.

⊖ Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shall thou labour, and do all thy work, but the Seventh Day is the Sabbath of the L-RD thy God; in it, thou shall not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates. For in six days the L-RD made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested the Seventh Day: wherefore the L-RD blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

⊖ Honour thy father and thy mother, that thy days may be long upon the land which the L-RD thy God is giving thee.

⊖ Thou shall not kill.

⊖ Thou shall not commit adultery.

⊖ Thou shall not steal.

⊖ Thou shall not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

⊖ Thou shall not covet thy neighbour's house; thou shall not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

Blessings Before The Shema (*Be Seated*)

בְּרוּךְ Blessed are You, L-RD our God, King of the Universe, Who forms light and creates darkness, Who makes peace and creates all things,^{ix} Who mercifully sheds light upon the earth and all who dwell on it, and Who, in His goodness, renews the light of creation every day continually. How many are Your works, O L-RD! In wisdom, You have made them! All the earth is filled with Your creations!^x He is the Lord of wonders, Who in His goodness renews the works of creation every day continually. And as it is said, “Give thanks to Him Who makes the great lights, for His loving-kindness endures forever.”^{xi} Cause Your light to shine upon Zion, and may we all soon enjoy its brightness. Blessed are You, L-RD, Creator of the luminaries.

With a Great Love

אֶהְבֶּה רַבָּה With great love You have loved us, O L-RD our God. With great and abundant compassion, You did have mercy on us. Our Father, Our King, for our fathers' sake who trusted in You, and to whom You did teach the instructions of

life; be gracious to us and teach us, too. Our Father, merciful Father, always compassionate, be merciful to us, and enable our hearts to understand, to hear, to learn, to teach, to do, and to fulfill—with love—all Your words of instruction. Enlighten our eyes to Your Torah, and cause our hearts to cling to Your commandments; unite our hearts to love and revere Your Name, that we may rejoice and be glad in Your salvation.

(Remain Seated. Shema is sung and eyes are covered to concentrate)

וְאָהַבְתָּ And you shall love the L-RD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. And these words which I am commanding you this day shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children; and shall talk of them when you sit in your home, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up. And you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlet bands between your eyes. And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.^{xiii}

וַיֹּאמֶר And the L-RD spoke to Moses saying, “Speak to the children of Israel and tell them to make fringes on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, putting a thread of blue upon the corner fringe. They will be a fringe for you to look upon and remember all the L-RD's commands, and do them, and that you follow not after your own eyes, after which you used to go astray. That you may remember and do all My commandments and be holy to your God. I am the L-RD your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt to be your God; I am the L-RD your God.”^{xiv}

Shemoneh Eserei

(Amidah: Remain Standing)

Congregation:

תְּהִלֹת O L-RD, open my lips and my mouth will declare Your praise.^{xvi}

בְּרוּךְ Blessed are You, L-RD our God and God of our fathers, God of Abraham, God of Isaac, God of Jacob, the great, mighty and awesome God^{xvii}, God supreme, Who extends loving-kindness and is Master of all, Who remembers the gracious deeds of our forefathers, and Who has brought a Redeemer with love to their children's children for His Name's sake.

King, Helper, Savior and Shield. Blessed are You, Shield of Abraham.

(Between Rosh HaShanna and Yom Kippur add : זְכַרְנוּ:

Remember us for life, King Who desires life, and inscribe us in the Book of Life—for Your own sake, O Living God.)

Shemonei Eserei (*continues*)

אֱתָהּ Your might is eternal, O Lord, Who revives the dead, powerful in saving, Who sustains the living with loving-kindness, Who revives the dead with great mercy, Who supports the falling, heals the sick, frees the captive, and keeps faith with the dead. Who is like You, Almighty, and who resembles You, O King? Who can bring death and give life, and can make Salvation blossom forth!

(*Between Rosh HaShanna and Yom Kippur add: מִי כָמוֹךָ*)

Who is like You, Merciful Father, Who recalls His creatures mercifully for life!

וְנֶאֱמָן And faithful are You to revive the dead.
Blessed are You, L-RD, Who revives the dead.

Kedushah (*aloud*)

אֶת עֲטָרָהּ A crown will they give You, O L-RD, our God—the angels of the multitude above, together with Your people Israel, who are assembled below. As it is written, they called to each other saying:

קְדוּשׁ

“Holy, holy, holy is the L-RD of Hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory.”^{xviii}

Those across from them say:

“Blessed be the glory of the L-RD from His abiding place.”^{xix}

אֱתָהּ קְדוּשׁ

You are holy, and Your Name is holy, and those who are holy shall praise you. Those who are holy shall praise You every day. Blessed are You, L-RD, the Holy God.

(*Between Rosh HaShanna and Yom Kippur substitute: בָּרוּךְ* Blessed are You, the Holy King.)

Shemonei Eserei (*continues*)

אֱלֹהֵינוּ Our God and God of our fathers, be pleased with our rest. Sanctify us through Your commandments and by the blood of Y'shua, and set our portion in Your Torah. Gratify us with Your goodness, gladden us through Your Salvation, and purify our hearts to serve You in truth. Give us Your holy Sabbath, L-RD our God, with love and favor as our heritage. And may Israel, who sanctifies Your Name, rest on it. Blessed are You, L-RD, Who sanctifies the Sabbath.

רְצֵה Be favorable, L-RD, our God, toward Israel your people, turn to their prayer and restore the service to the Holy of Holies of Your House. And the fire offerings of Israel and their prayers may you speedily accept with love and favor, and may the service of your people Israel be continually favorable to You.

וְתַחֲזִינָהּ May our eyes behold Your return to Zion in compassion. Blessed are You, L-RD, Who restores His Shekinah to Zion.

מוֹדִים We gratefully thank You, for it is You Who are the L-RD, our God and the God of our forefathers forever. Our Rock, the Rock of our lives, Shield of our Salvation are You from generation to generation. We shall thank You and relate Your praise:^{xx} for our lives, which are committed to Your power, and for our souls that are entrusted to You; for Your miracles that are with us every day; and for Your wonders and favors in every season—evening, morning, and afternoon; the Good One, for Your compassions were never exhausted, and the Compassionate One, for Your kindnesses never ended^{xxi}—for we have always put our hope in You. For all these, may Your Name be blessed, exalted, and extolled, our King, continually forever and ever.

(Between Rosh HaShanna and Yom Kippur add: וְכָתוּב

And inscribe all the children of Your covenant for a good life.)

וְכֹל Everything alive will gratefully acknowledge You, Selah! And praise and bless Your great Name sincerely, forever, for it is Good. O God of our salvation and help, Selah! The God who is Good. Blessed are You, L-RD; Your Name is “The Good,” and to You, it is fitting to give thanks.

Shemonei Eserei (*continues whispered*)

שְׁלוֹם Grant shalom to Your people Israel forever, for You are Sovereign Master of all shalom. And it is good in Your eyes to bless Your people Israel at all times and in every hour with Your shalom.

(*Between Rosh HaShanna and Yom Kippur add: בְּסֵפֶר*

In the Book of Life, the book of blessing, and peace, good livelihood, good decrees, salvations and consolations, may we be remembered and inscribed before You—we and Your entire people, the House of Israel, for a good life and for peace.)

בְּרַחֵם Blessed are You, O L-RD, Who blesses His people Israel with Shalom.

Congregation (*sung*): **יְהִי** May the words that proceed out of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be found to be acceptable to Thee, O L-RD, my Rock and my Redeemer.^{xxii}

(All Rise. Please remain standing and facing the scroll while it is in motion.)

Cantor: אֵין There is none like unto Thee among the gods, O L-RD, and there are no works like Thine.^{xxiii} Your Kingdom is a Kingdom for all eternities and Your reign for generation after generation.^{xxiv} The L-RD reigns. The L-RD has reigned. The L-RD shall reign for all eternity.^{xxv} The L-RD will give might to His people; the L-RD will bless His people with peace.^{xxvi}

Congregation: וַיְהִי And it came to pass, whenever the ark went forward, Moses would say: “Arise, O L-RD, and let Your enemies be scattered; let those who hate You flee before You.”^{xxvii}

(Blessed are You, O L-RD our God, King of the Universe, Who has chosen us from among all people, and has given us His Torah. Blessed are You, Giver of the Torah. Amen.)

Torah Reading

Blessing After Reading

Reader: בָּרַךְ Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, asher natan lanu Torat emet, v'chayei olam natah b'tochenu. Baruch atah Adonai, noten ha-Torah. Amen.
(Blessed are You, O L-RD our God, King of the Universe, Who has given us the Torah of truth, and has thereby planted everlasting life in our midst. Blessed are You, O L-RD, Giver of the Torah. Amen.)
